

Criteria for Application to the Cardiff Medical Society Bursaries for Elective Students (three bursaries available for £250-00 each).

1] The bursaries are open to all 5th year students of the Cardiff University School of Medicine undertaking an approved elective period.

2] The elective should be spent doing a defined project, the nature of which and the methods to be used should be outlined in the application.

3] The proposed project should show innovation. We are not looking for a travelogue with a list of case histories.

4] The project should be based on an area of health care that would benefit the community or population they were visiting with a prospect the benefit would continue after the student has left.

5] The bursary would enable the project to be improved, expanded, refined or even undertaken in the first place. If possible an indication how the bursary would facilitate this.

6] The successful applicants would be required to give a 10 to 15 minute presentation to the Society in December. Thought should be given to making this presentation of interest to the Society. You will receive your award at this meeting.

Obviously not all these criteria will be met in all the applications, but this is guidance as to what the Committee of the Cardiff Medical Society are seeking. Applications should be sent to Dr Les Dingley at: lesdingley@msn.com
